

What is the Transcript Evaluation Service (TES)?

Program Description

- Evaluates student academic records to determine UC and CSU eligibility status.
- Two levels of evaluation: a) automated evaluation performed by UC's proprietary algorithm, and b) subsequent manual evaluation performed by a UC trained evaluator.
- Includes all 9th – 12th graders at a school.
- Courses are verified again UC's Course Management Portal (CMP), the authorized database of all approved A-G coursework.
- Evaluation variables include all applicable subject area validations (including by test score), dual enrollment courses, out of district coursework.

Participating Schools in TES see the following results:

- ✓ **Two consecutive years = 10% increase in CSU & UC eligibility**
- ✓ **Four consecutive years = 32% increase for CSU & 22% increase for UC eligibility**
- ✓ **A-G completion rates = 36% increase after four years**
- ✓ **UC applications rates at all TES schools and districts increase in relative to time in TES Program**
