- Pressure wash black Algae with 5000 psi to remove algae heads
- Chlorine wash plaster surface
- Let plaster dry in sun for 1 week (7 days)
- Pressure wash remaining black algae and chlorine
- Light acid wash plaster surface
- Refill pool
- All employees will be fitted for proper PPE

#### **EXCLUSIONS**

- New main drain grates and return fittings – existing will be used
- Fill Pools
- Start-up and coordination of existing mechanical equipment
- Brushing of plaster after full
- Balancing chemicals and filling of bulk storage tanks
- Pool maintenance
