**J.1. Superintendent's Report**

Minutes:

Acting Superintendent Carlos R. Gonzales reported on the following:  
Robotics Team- He reported that the CHS Robotics Team is competing in San Diego and wished them luck in the competition.  
School Safety- He reported that several communications have been sent out to the community and staff regarding school climate. School safety continues to be the district's top priority. He commended staff who presented today regarding facilities upgrades, the implementation of programs and the use of additional personnel to provide a safer environment for our students and staff. Programs and software have been implemented which takes time and effort. More staff are on board who can address the social and emotional needs of our students.

**J.2. Measure V Update**

Minutes:

Mrs. Randle stated that Mr. Sanders will be present at the March 22, 2018 board meeting.  
She stated that the Measure V oversight committee vacancy has been advertised, and the application deadline is tomorrow.

### **J.3. Association Comments (ACT/CSEA)**

Minutes:

Mr. James Taylor, ACT President, stated that yesterday was the annual Read Across America Event at the Enrique Camarena Library which was well attended.

Earlier today ACT dialogued with the Superintendent about the closure of Imagine. Imagine offers a dual immersion program and he will talk to the Superintendent to discuss this possibility. He commended the district for keeping teachers and staff in the loop in regards to safety.

He stated that the CHS entrance gates are closed early, and there is a swing gate on the east side of the school which has gaps in the gate. ACT recommends getting a motorized gate opener and issue to staff some sort of remote controls to enter. Many months ago ACT submitted a grievance on overages for shop teachers. The Superintendent has requested a meeting, and they hope this meeting will be successful. This is a violation of the contract and requested that a hearing be held in April. ACT formally makes a request and he delivered a letter to the Board President and the Superintendent.

Sonia Redona, CSEA President, informed the Board that they held their 12th negotiation session with legal present. There are qualified administrators who can negotiate, the district has paid the lawyer over \$29,000. ACT does not have a lawyer at the table. CSEA deserves a 5% since there is a me-too clause. There are 3 board members that are up for re-election. Classified staff deserve better.

### **J.4. Insurance Committee**

Minutes:

Mr. Carlos Gonzales reported that the insurance committee met on March 5, 2018 and had great representation from both unions and no issues or concerns were reported by the membership. For the 2018-19 school year there was a 39% increase which was brought down to about 19%. The concern is that this quote is still too high since it represents a \$2.6 million increase to the health benefits. He reported that the district is going out to market to look at other plans. The next meeting is scheduled for March 28, 2018 at 3:30 pm at the district office.

### **ROP Committee**

Minutes:

Trustee Castillo reported that a lot of positive comments have been made with students participating at the fair. He thanked the AG teachers. Next Thursday, March 15th is the Youth Education Summit. On March 22, 2018 there is a county-wide welding competition and on March 28, 2018 there is a law enforcement competition too. He stated that Mr. John Moreno will be dancing with the stars. ROP has scholarships available online now. ROP has been supportive of the Calxico Educational Foundation as well.
